Publication of the Final Thesis

HTW Berlin publishes the final theses of its students in the university library. Users of the library can view and lend the published theses. For this purpose, personal data are collected in the online catalogue (webOPAC) of HTW Berlin and in Dandelon¹. Amongst those personal data are the author's first and family name, the title of the thesis and the year of graduation. Furthermore, the front page and the table of contents of the thesis are digitised as pdf files and included in the online catalogue. This allows the machine-based research in indexes for all users of the online catalogue. The data processed in the online catalogue of HTW Berlin is also capable of being searched and referenced by global web search engines/webcrawlers, which do not fall within the power of control of HTW Berlin. HTW Berlin is only responsible for the processing of data in the webOPAC and Dandelon catalogues.
